

Caustinerf Deciduous

Paste for dental use

PATIENT INFORMATION LEAFLET

Please read this leaflet carefully before you start using this medicine. It tells you the important points you should know about CAUSTINERF DECIDUOUS.

Pharmaceutical form

Paste for dental use.

What's in your medicine

This paste contains 8 g of parachlorophenol, 13 g of camphor, 36 g of lidocaine base and 18 g of paraformaldehyde per 100 g.

It also includes other ingredients: ferrosferic oxide, vinyl chloride acetate copolymer and polyethylene fibers.

CAUSTINERF DECIDUOUS is available in opal glass jars of 4.5 g.

About your medicine

CAUSTINERF DECIDUOUS contains four active ingredients. These include two antiseptics, one anaesthetic agent and one devitalising ingredient. This medicine can only be given to you by your dentist. It is most commonly used to devitalise deciduous teeth.

Before this medicine is used

Before this paste is used, tell your dentist if:

- you have been given CAUSTINERF DECIDUOUS before and had an allergic reaction (rashes, swelling, itching or difficulty in breathing).
- you are taking any other medicines, including those you have bought yourself without a prescription.
- you are sensitive to any of the active ingredients in CAUSTINERF DECIDUOUS.

How this medicine will be used

Your dentist knows how to use CAUSTINERF DECIDUOUS. He will give you the dose needed, which depends on the treatment you are having.

The usual dose of CAUSTINERF DECIDUOUS is 10 mg. Your dentist will apply it to the tooth to be treated. If you see another dentist or go into hospital, tell them what medicines you are taking.

What to do if an overdose is taken

If you (or someone else) swallow a lot of the paste, or if you think a child has swallowed any of it, contact your nearest hospital casualty department or dentist immediately.

Unwanted effects

CAUSTINERF DECIDUOUS, like most other medicines, may cause side effects in some patients. Most side effects are nothing to worry

about. If you develop any side effects and they are severe or they get worse, or last for more than a few days, contact your dentist.

Storing your medicine

It is most unlikely that you will be given this medicine to look after. Your dentist will not use any of the paste after the expiry date printed on the container. If you have any medicines, which are out of date, return them to your pharmacist for disposal.

Keep all medicines in a safe place where children cannot reach them.

This paste will be stored below 25°C.

Do not keep any medicines you no longer need; give them back to your pharmacist for disposal.

Further information

Remember, this medicine is only for you. Only a dentist can prescribe it for you. Never give it to anyone else, even if it sounds as though they have the same problem as you. It may harm them.
